# Need a Ticket to Ride

Cincinnati's streetcar, formally known as the Cincinnati Bell Connector, marked its first anniversary of operation last month. Operating on a 3.6-mile loop, the Connector takes riders from The Banks near the Ohio River to historic Over-the-Rhine through the heart of downtown.

There are 18 stations along the route. Most feature covered shelters and steel benches. All stations have a real-time next streetcar arrival screen and ticket vending machines. Cost to ride is \$1 for a two-hour pass or \$2 for a day pass. You can also use the Cincy EZRide app on a smartphone. The Connector operates on the honor system. But there's a \$100 fine if you can't produce a ticket when an inspector asks.

Designed to run every 15 minutes or so, Connector hours are: Monday-Thursday, 6:30 a.m. to midnight; Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 1 a.m., Saturday, 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. and Sunday & holidays, 9 a.m. to 11 p.m.
